Board Meeting Minutes
August 5, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Club President, Tillie Wietharn at 6:40 p.m. at the home of Judy Fetter. Eleven members were in attendance.

Minutes: Harold Bassett moved to accept the minutes of the July 1, 2007 meeting. Ron Tobey seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. The next meeting is scheduled to be held on September 6, 2007 at Jeanie Porter's house.

Committee Reports

Treasurer Report: Linda Wenz provided the Board with the July 2007 financial statements. The cash balance on hand is \$8,648.00. Josh Neugebauer reported that the Lakewood Tennis Tournament lost approximately \$400.

Membership Report: Harold Bassett reported that the Club has 232 members to date. There are 12 new members this month. Of the 12 new members 10 of them requested getting their *Lobber* by email. The Club is now mailing only 57 newsletters.

Activity Director (Socials): Bruce McKay reported that 22 members of LTA have signed up for the Wash Park Challenge. Wash Park has only signed up 14 players. Bruce will encourage Wash Park's President, June Woodrich, to come up with more players. The 4.0 and 4.5 teams will be responsible for providing breakfast and lunch for the Wash Park Challenge.

Newsletter: The deadline for the September *Lobber* is August 24th. Jeanie Porter will mail out the new membership amendment list with the September *Lobber*.

Tournaments: Josh Neugebauer reported that Lakewood Tournament drew 125 participants. Last year the Tournament drew about 150 participants. Josh received a lot of positive feedback on the tournament from non-Lakewood members. Harold suggested that next year the Club should set a goal to break even on this event.

Josh reported that 20 people have signed up for Vail.

Web Page Update: Josh reported for Sue Honaker. Sue is working on updating the website. Harold suggested that old items such as prior year's minutes be removed from the website.

Intra Club Coordinators

Men's: Tom Murphy reported that the City of Lakewood is going to put up new bulletin boards at Lakewood and Morris Parks. The new bulletin boards will have locks. He did not know when these would be installed.

Anthony Boone noted that tree limbs are encroaching on one of the courts at Morris Park. Also, many of the center straps on the courts are missing. Ron Tobey will notify the City of these problems.

Women's & Mixed: Tillie reported for Linda Maisonneuve . Tille noted that we have two 7.5 mixed doubles teams signed up for the fall leagues.
